SUBJECT: Policy Regarding UCSD Faculty Club Membership and Club Use

We are pleased with the large and growing role that the Faculty Club plays in providing a place for faculty, management and professional staff to meet socially and to conduct business during the lunch period. We extend a cordial invitation to all of you to membership in the Club.

While most of us feel that holding membership in the Club is the right thing to do in support of our campus as well as for reaping personal benefits from the interchanges accomplished at the location, there has been some confusion as to membership policies. Let me attempt to clarify the situation.

Faculty, professional researchers, academic administrators, executive management, MAP and A&PS personnel must be members to use the Club for luncheon service, continental breakfast, happy hours, membership events, etc. Non-members in these categories may be occasional guests of members but not on a regular basis, e.g., weekly or monthly. Membership is required of retired/emeritus persons in the above ranks but we recognize their special status through reduced dues. All other persons in the University community, students and persons who do not have University appointments may be guests of Club members without any restrictions as to the number of times invited. In fact, frequent invitations are encouraged and such persons also are welcomed into membership.

Departmental memberships are for conducting official University business at the Club. The Club costs incurred using a departmental membership must be recharged to a University budget. Cash is not accepted. Either a member or non-member may use a departmental card at the Club for University business as allowed by the sponsoring department.

The meeting rooms and the lounge (at appropriate times) may be reserved at any time during the day by non-members as well as members for meetings and food service but members will have first priority on their use.

The Club will continue to extend complimentary temporary memberships to visiting scholars and others who are on campus for a short period of time. Please extend an invitation to any of your visiting colleagues to come by the Club and request a temporary membership. Reciprocity also is honored from sister institutions.

We hope to see you at the Club often as members and wish you the best during the 1993 year. Please feel free to contact the Director, Tom Mignano, for membership information and application forms.
