

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED REVISIONS

PPM 160-9 – Student Organizations Policy

The Office of Student Conduct is proposing a set of revisions to the campus Student Organizations Policy (PPM 160-9). The Policy is currently in its regular three year review and the revisions reflect updates and changes to the current language. The proposed revisions include:

- Removing the definition of College Student Organizations. While this definition is included in the *Policy*, the term is not used in the body of the Policy Statement as it applies to Registered Student Organizations only. The Council of Deans of Student Affairs (CDSA) have determined a separate College Student Organizations Policy is necessary and plan to work on a draft policy during the 2022-23 academic year.
- Inclusion of language noting that Registered Student Organizations are not eligible to register with undergraduate colleges, the Division of Graduate Education and Postdoctoral Affairs, or academic/professional school as a college-based or other student organization. This change was made to make clear the singular registration status of Registered Student Organizations.
- Decrease of the number of required Principal Members for Registered Student Organizations from four to three. The Center for Student Involvement requested the change to make it easier for organizations to register as a Registered Student Organization.
- Update the Director of Student Conduct's title to Director – Student Affairs Policy, Standards, and Conduct.

The Policy will be reviewed by the UC San Diego Student Conduct Group, which will provide feedback to the Office of Student Conduct prior to the normal campus comment period.
