### II. POLICY

The Regents' and State Assembly actions:

- A. Prohibit the use of State tax funds for parking facilities on University campuses; and
- B. Require that all vehicles parked thereon be subject to an annual fee sufficient to cover the cost of construction, maintenance, and administration of parking facilities.

The Transportation & Parking Services Department is charged with responsibility for the management and control of parking on the UCSD campus, at the Medical Centers and on other satellite properties under its jurisdiction such as the Scripps Institution of Oceanography.

Transportation & Parking Services operates as a self-supporting Auxiliary Enterprise under the jurisdiction of Auxiliary and Plant Services.

In 1982, UCSD took over the processing and collection of parking citations from the San Diego Municipal Court. As part of that agreement, the court stipulated that any funds collected, beyond the cost of collecting, be used for alternative transportation and rideshare programs and promotion.
